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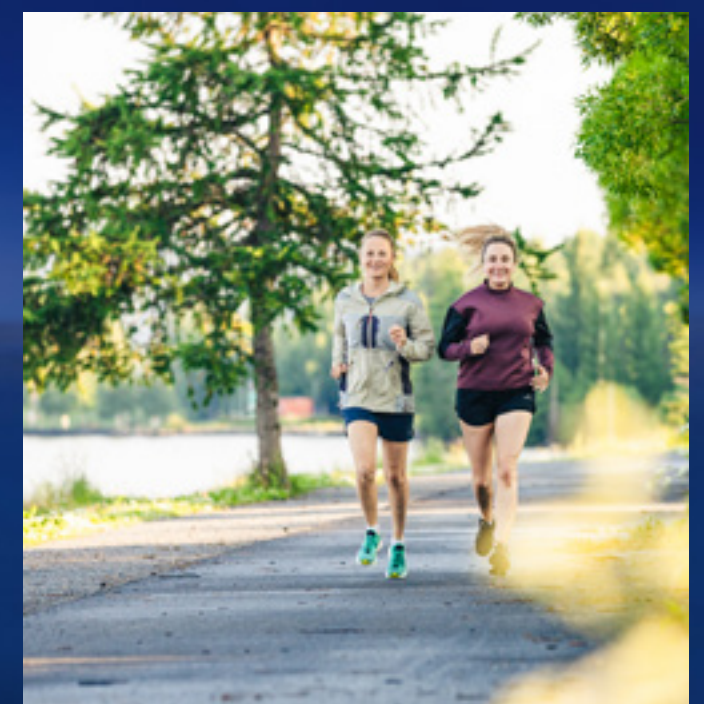

The summer in Östersund is full of events.

Storsjöyran Festival 40 years

📍 Central Östersund

📅 The festival July 28–30. Krogstråket July 21–30

2023 Storsjöyran celebrates its 40th anniversary! Yran is one of Sweden's largest music festivals with about 40 artists on seven stages. Here the national and international big names meet local acts, the broad artists share the stage with narrow expressions. Here the popular is mixed with the avant-garde, the familiar with the unexpected. That's why Yran is called "the festival like no other".

Storsjöyran takes place in central Östersund and some of the artists this year are: Ava Max, Carola, Benjamin Ingrosso, Johnossi, Hooja, Jireel, Beharie och Mor.

Yran is also surrounded by the world's longest party week, the ten-day Yran week, this year starting on 21 July. The Yran week consists of film, art, theatre, installations, exhibitions and surprises. The harbor is also a part of the festival area. During the Yran week a number of restaurants move here, together forming the "Krogstråket". On the other side of Badhusparken you find the festivals amusement park, which is also open throughout the Yran week.

JAMTLI - THREE MUSEUMS IN ONE PLACE

Jamtli can be described as three museums in one place. Here you can visit the open-air museum with animals, cultural-historical houses and nice walking paths. In the county museum's cultural history exhibitions, you experience Jämtland's county history in different times and from several perspectives. The National Museum Jamtli displays art and design from the National Museum's collections.

During the period 24 June – 20 August, the open-air museum will be transformed into Jamtli Historieland. The cultural-historical environments from 1785 to 1975 are filled with role-playing games and with a few steps you move between different centuries. The people you meet are from a different time than our own and they are happy to tell you about their work, their everyday life and their dreams. Here you learn about the 18th century's lean years of need or the city of Östersund 1895 with a shop and a market. Take a ride in the bus from 1920 or stop at the gas station from 1956.

Inside Jamtli you will find the county museum's cultural history exhibitions. The museum's most interesting artefact is undoubtedly Överhogdalsbonaderna – Europe's oldest pictorial tapestries.

Woven textiles containing motives and symbols from both the Norse mythology and the entry of Christianity.

At Jamtli you will also find the National Museum Jamtli. This year's exhibition "Ideal and reality – Nordic nature" is about how Nordic nature is depicted in arts and crafts from the 17th century onwards. The exhibition shows paintings, drawings, photos and handicrafts, all from the National Museum's collections. Among the artists are names like Anna Boberg, Otto Hesselbom, Pehr Hilleström, Bruno Liljefors, Helmer Osslund but also more contemporary ones like Frida Fjellman, Kerstin Hörnlund, and Per B Sundberg.

FOOD AND MORE

Östersund is a great place to visit if you are interested in discovering Swedish food. The city is an appointed UNESCO Creative City of Gastronomy.

We have a long-lasting culinary tradition based on locally produced sustainable food. Make sure to try char, moose and reindeer, cheese from our local farm dairies and our award winning beers and sparkling wine.



CREATIVE HIGHTS

Saluhallen and it´s sister restaurant **Jazzköket** focuses on local and organic soul food. The inner courtyard is well appreciated by locals an visitors alike. **Nästgårds** i Lit, north of Östersund, is a popular summer open farm restaurant with fixed menues and beautiful surroundings. **Nästgårds Bua** in Östersund serves small or large dishes with Jämtland and Nordic focus. **Slaktar'n** with wine bar **19 Glas** is a welcome addition to Östersunds gastronomic heaven.

WIDE TASTE PALETTE MENU

Kitchen and Table at Clarion, **Republiken** and **Tre Rum** all serve a wide variety of delicate dishes. If you like meat, don't miss out on **Texas Longhorn** or the fondue at **En liten röd**.

OUT INTO THE WORLD

Focus on Asian fusion and great wines has the newly opened restaurant **Astrid**. Concept restaurants at **Pinchos** and **Taco Bar**. Tasty Indian food, sushi bars and Asian options abound. An exciting newcomer in town is the small Czech tavern **Bistro Žižkov**. Taste experiences from Greece can be found at **Grekiska Grill & Bar**. A taste of summer holiday at **Teaterträdgård'n** prestigiously delightful with drinks, food and entertainment. At **Tiki Grill / Drinks**, menus are influenced from the tropical islands.

FANCY A PUB?

Pub menues in classic British vintage can be found at **Dalwhinnie**, **Bishop Arms** and **Sir Winston**. Popular home-made burgers at **Tages** on Frösön, also a café.

CIAO ITALIA

Into Italian food? Don´t miss out on **Gusto**. In addition to excellent pizza and pasta there is also a section for the burger-hungry. The inner courtyard comes alive with a drink bar during warm summer evenings. Colorful **Basta Urban Italian** is a newcomer. A solid selection of craft beers and playful pizza with local toppings you find at Artut.

CLOSE TO NATURE

Arctura, 55 m above ground, at the Ski Stadium offers lunches with a magnificent view. Take the **M/S Thomée** and enjoy a cruise with food onboard or at **Verkön** in the archipelago. **Tivars restaurant and dairy** on Norderön offers more than fantastic cheeses with food and drinks on the jetty. Get here by car or by boat.

SWEDISH FIKA

Norra Station is a cultural hub with music, art exhibitions and lovely fika and light meals. **Hamngatan 12** places you in the middle of an interior design shop paired with fika and food in an old storage building. Both with nice outdoor seating on warm summer days.

The Ecocafée focuses on health, raw food and vegetarian dishes. **Nummer Ett** offers brunch all day as well as a popular after work. Classic cafés with "Swedish smörgåstårter" and pastries are **Wedemarks** and **Edenbos**. Urban coffee shops are **Espresso House** and **Waynes**.

In Östersund biking is always around. Nice country roads, lots of XC trails and the downhill cycling at Östberget is considered high class.



Östersund Bike Fest

26 June – 2 July. Lots of organized events and tours, workshops and guided cycling fun with local cyclists. The week ends with the Swedish Cup competitions in Enduro at Östberget during the weekend.



Trail cycling

The Östersund area is said to host some of the nicest XC trails in the country. Technical trails around Andersön and Frösön. Fun paths at Fursteli with it's 11 kilometers of built and marked paths. With the app Trailforks or Strava you also find combinations of XC trails and gravel from Böle and south on. Starting from Östersund Ski Stadium you will find a marked cycle path of 13 kilometers to combine with other existing paths in the area around Spikbodarna.

Downhill/Enduro

The downhill biking at Frösön has fine trails and a wide range of difficulty levels up to more technical with large drops, rock sections and steep slopes. The lift in Gustavsbergsbacken (open 5 days a week) pulls you up, other days it is cycling uphill that applies.

Playful Brunflo Bikepark has no lift but several fun short lines and a pump track for cycling fun. In Böle, above the camp site in Sandviken, there are also a number of enduro tracks to whiz down and grind up. Beginner? Rent a bike at Lagg & Hoj.

Gravel biking

Gravel cycling is the next big biking trend and Östersund has a never-ending network of dirt roads north and northeast of town for the hybrid between MTB and road cycling. Follow "Jämtgrus" on Instagram and Strava, do routes in Komoot or just look at the land surveyor's map service "My map" and create your own rounds. With gravel you will never get lost, it will just be another road.

Road biking

Beautiful surroundings, ice cream stop in Ytterån, intervals between ferries at Isön and Norderön. There are plenty of winding roads and the lengths can be varied easily.

Cycling, which does not include electric bicycles, is covered by the right of public access. You who cycle must therefore follow the guidelines that apply. And remember to always show consideration for those walking or riding.

DISCOVER STORSJÖN



Östersund is surrounded by waters. Lake Storsjön is Sweden's fifth largest lake and around town you find plenty of other lakes and rivers – all great for a summer water adventure.



By kayak / canoe on lakes

Gliding along the mirror-like surface of Lake Storsjön on a still summer evening, with the snow-capped mountains in view is unbeatable. For those who are fit and familiar with paddling, a tour around Frösön island (some 30 km) might be an exciting challenge. Two other nice tours are around Andersön island (just over 10 km) and from the city along the shoreline of Frösön into the bay between Frösön and Bynäset. Kayaks and canoes can be rented in the harbor or at Tivars on Norderön island.

And on flowing waters

Indalsälven, Långan and Härkan that are all rivers to the north of Östersund offering a wide variety of paddling experiences perfect to combine with fishing, for example, brown trout and grayling.

At Lits camping and canoe rental centre they have compiled a range of different tour options. Whether you are a beginner or advanced, want to be out for half a day or a whole week, there is something for you.

By SUP

Stand Up Paddling is the perfect combination of water sport and nature experience. Rent a SUP and discover lake Storsjön or close by lakes like Locknesjön with its green waters.

Surf & kite

Östersund often features strong winds and playful waves, making it a popular place for all kinds of surfers. On our website we list the most popular spots. Remember to wear a dry suit as the water seldom reaches over 18 degrees Celsius.

Aboard a boat

M/S Thomée

M/S Thomée operates Storsjön's water with trips to Verkön island and the castle restaurant with its summer terrace. The voyage takes about 1.5 hours. Food and drink are also served on board.

Sjöexpressen

From Norderön you can take the Sjö-expressen to Verkön.

For groups – Rib boat SuperTornado

The Rib boat SuperTornado takes only 20 minutes from Östersund harbor to Verkön. Passengers are equipped with float overalls, life jackets and goggles.

SUMMER AND SWIMMING

Östersund is located next to the 5th largest lake in Sweden, and there are many wonderful spots for bathing, whether you want to hang out at the beach or prefer to dip your toes into a pool.

Near the City Centre you will find **Dalhems-parken**, with a diving tower and a number of jetties. Just nearby is also **Birgers adventure park** a pump track and an outdoor gym, perfect warm up before a dip in the lake.

On Frösön at **Bynäset**, you'll find a long shallow bay for bathing, with a stony beach

and stunning views of the mountains. The area has some simple services such as a barbecue area and an outside toilet.

The island of **Andersön** is a popular destination. It is a nature reserve, 15 km from Östersund. Along its beautiful stony beaches there are many cosy, long shallow bays where you can enjoy a swim with a view of the mountains, and there are also trails for walking or jogging. 15 km from the city at **Lits campsite** the Indalsälven river flows along. There is a lovely sandy beach at "Älmlagunen" (River lagoon), beach volleyball and fantastic fishing. You are welcome to

swim there, even if you are not staying on the camp site.

At **Hara pier**, people go swimming from the old Steamboat pier. Here is a popular summer café that is run by the local villagers, always homemade goodies on the menu.

Storsjöbadet adventure pools is fun whatever the weather. It has several outside pools, large green areas, a beach volleyball pitch and a large playground. Inside, there is an adventure pool with three water slides, a climbing wall and bubble pools. And the very youngest get their own pool with water slides and a fountain



ACTIVITIES FOR THE WHOLE FAMILY

Summer holidays – the perfect time for the family to hang out together. In Östersund there are a lot of fun activities for the children both indoors and outdoors. Here we have collected some tips with family activities for eventful and wonderful days in Östersund.



Playgrounds

In Badhusparken, down by lake Storsjön there is a popular playground for the youngest and the green area invites you to run and play. There is also a mini golf course and café. In Birger the little great lake monster's adventure park next to the pedestrian bridge on Frösön you can climb, jump and run. Everyone who likes to come and play is welcome here, both children and adults. And great lake monsters.



Teknikland

At Optand Airfield south of Östersund you find a comprehensive retro-technical world of aero planes, vintage cars/buses and military history.



Swimming

There are many wonderful spots for bathing, whether you want to hang out at the beach or prefer to dip your toes into a pool. On Bynäset and Andersön there are shallow bays with a nice view of the mountains, perfect for an outing with a picnic or barbecue. For those who prefer to swim in the pool or indoors, there is Storsjöbadet with a children's area, fun water slides, a trampoline and a relaxation area. Read more on page 15.

Travel in time at Jamtli

Jamtli Historieland is an open-air museum with children's activities, time travel and historical exhibitions.

Jamtli offers an exciting journey through the history of Jämtland and Härjedalen and you will enjoy being part of history.

The children can also try their skills at the art studio at the National Museum Jamtli.



Tame elks at Moose Garden

Meet the king of the forest and the Jämtland heraldic animal in an unusual and close encounter. At Moose Garden you make the acquaintance of tame elks. On the guided tour you get to pat the moose and learn facts about their life.



Pump track and skateboard

At Frösön, next to the jetties, diving tower and the outdoor gym, you find a popular pump track where the kids train their technique on bikes, kicks or skateboards, busy with riders all day long. On the city side of the bridge, there is a skatepark with manual pads and rails.

Bangården is an indoor skate hall, close to the city center. Gustavsbergsbacken on Frösön offers downhill cycling. Here are marked trails from the top of Östberget in several difficulty levels. At Brunflo Bike Park, 15 km south of Östersund you find cycling with drops, waves and curves – the perfect training environment for the whole family and on Frösön there are plenty of mountain bike XC tracks.



Multi Challenge adventure house & Tiki Grill / drinks

A house full of activities and challenges. Try out go karting, the laser dome, the play land or enter the world of Boda Borg, where you solve tasks as a group and collect stamps on quests.

At Tiki, next door to Multi Challenge you will find bowling, shuffleboards, billiards, UV golf and darts. If you get hungry there is a large selection of nice food and drink in the Tiki restaurant.



Hiking with children

Andersön's Nature Trail. The family trail on Andersön extends over approximately 2,1 kilometers. Along the way there are animal tracks and information about nature and animals.

The Children's Pilgrim's trail on Frösön. A mini format of the Pilgrim track St. Olavsleden. Here is a short trail where you can follow the children Emma and Magnus on a pilgrimage via mobile phone and QR code.

Ändsjön – go birdwatching. One of the prettiest and most accessible birding sites is without a doubt Ändsjön's nature reserve on Frösön island. A constructed walking trail of 3 km circles the lake and there is a birdwatching tower.

FRÖSÖN

– Lake Storsjön's largest Island

Frösön welcomes you to experience its nature, adventure, cultural history and a wonderful view - over Lake Storsjön, towards the mountains Oviksfjällen and Åreskutan. Frösön was for centuries the center of Jämtland, inhabited since prehistoric times and long before Östersund was founded there was a school, post office, military training and the free parliament "Jamtamot" was held here. The island got its name from the god of fertility, Frö.



Frösö Church

One of Sweden's most popular wedding churches. For thousands of years this has been sacred ground. The 12th century church was built on the site of an ancient pagan place of sacrifice. At Frösö Church there is a pilgrim center that is open during the summer when it is high season for pilgrimages. As a pilgrim, you can also camp in the area. Take the opportunity to see exhibitions, listen to music, learn more from the guides and for the children there is a special pilgrimage.

Frösö Hembygdsgrd / Stocke Titt

Here Jämtlands first school "Frösö Trivialskola" was once located. Today, an exhibition is shown in the old library building about life at the school for the roughly 100 students from 1679 to 1847. The homestead farm just next door houses a café and an viewing tower.

Frösötornet

From the viewing tower at Frösön, situated 468 m above sea level, you can see all the way to Norway on a clear day. There are popular running/walking tracks in the nearby forest and a White Guide recommended café serving raw food sweets.

The Rune Stone

Adjacent to the bridge that leads to Östersund stands Sweden's northernmost rune stone. The inscriptions carved in the 1050's states that Östman, Gudfast's son, erected a bridge across the sound and brought Christianity to Jämtland.

Sommarhagen museum

The home of composer and music critic Wilhelm Peterson-Berger is one of Sweden's most interesting design artefacts. The audio guides provide information about Peterson-Bergers eventful life and his music. Café on the premises.

Bird watching at Ändsjön

Frösön's only lake Ändsjön is a nice nature reserve. Around 40 bird species breed here. Around the lake there is a 2.5 km long path and two bird towers are set up in the reserve. Make sure to bring along binoculars!

Bynäset

Bynäset offers nice trails for walking or trail running along the 7 km route. At Västbyviken you find one of Östersunds most popular beaches with barbecue facilities.

Biking

Frösön is popular among XC- and downhill bikers. Read more on biking on pages 12-13.

Golf & outdoor training

Östersund-Frösö Golf Range is famous for its beautiful settings. 18 holes, 9 holes Pay and Play course and driving range. Next doors you find Frösö Park Hotel with a large outdoor gym and obstacle course.

Frösö Park SPA

An inviting oasis for everyone who wants to relax. The Spa has been designed using old Jämtlandic traditions as its inspiration. Here you can choose from four different types of sauna. Two pools, one indoors and one outdoors. Bubble footbath, ice pool and spa treatments.

Walk in historical surroundings

St. Olavsleden, the world's northernmost pilgrimage trail, passes Frösön on its way to Nidaros in Trondheim. Mjällestigen, with remains from the Iron Age, Stensgårdsstigen and Kyrkstigen are other popular hiking routes on Frösön.

Eat well

There are plenty of cafés and restaurants at Frösön so there is no need to go hungry. Try the typical "Frösö kisses" pastry or the smashing burgers at Tages, homemade cookies and buns at Stocke Titt. Have a lunch at Frösö Park Hotel or take a coffee after visiting the Wilhelm Peterson-Berger Museum at Sommarhagen Café. Enjoy the magnificent views and traditional Swedish fika at Frösövallen café. More cozy places to eat at Frösön on our website.



NATURE NEARBY

In Östersund, Lake Storsjön and the mountains are always nearby and around Östersund there are several places to discover nature. Fill your bag with a picnic and something to quench your thirst and choose the location and what you want to do and head out!

Hiking and walking

St. Olavsleden is the world's northernmost pilgrim trail. It's about 580 km long starting in Selånger just outside Sundsvall and finishes at Nidaros Cathedral in Trondheim, where Olav the Saint is buried.

Andersön island is a popular place for families, those who are active and others. Long and beautiful pebble beaches, gnarled pines, fossils, and ancient monuments. There is a multitude of forest paths in the surrounding forests for those who want to jog, bike, stroll or pick mushrooms and berries.

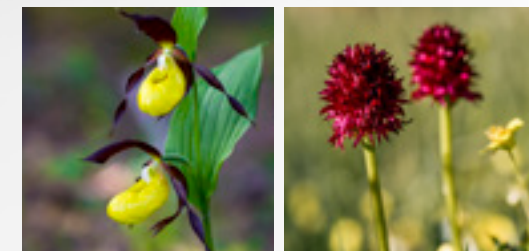
Next to Sunne Church is nature and the meditation path **Pärlstigen**. 1.5 km long and mostly accessible for those with disabilities.

At the beautiful **Bynåset**, you can run, cycle or walk around the peninsula which measures 7 km. At Västbyviken right next door there is a long black sandy beach and open lawns for picnics and play.

On **Frösön Island** there are many beautiful trails and paths to explore. Mjällestigen, Stensgårdsstigen, Kyrkstigen, and Östberget's Nature Trail all offer beautiful views of the lake and mountains.

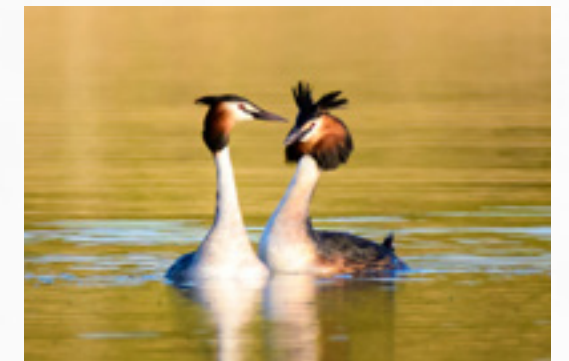
Watch birds

One of the prettiest and most accessible birding sites is without a doubt **Ändsjöns nature reserve** on Frösön island. A walking trail of 3 km circles the lake and there are birdwatching towers on the south and northern end. There are large numbers of different species of ducks, such as the great crested grebe, horned grebe, common pochard, coot, common teal, cranes, brown harrier and many small birds. **Tysjöarna nature reserve** is located just north of Östersund. It's a lovely 10 km walk around the lakes. The northern entrance has a more even pathway making the area accessible with prams, wheelchairs and walkers.



... and orchids

At **Nästmyren** you will find our landscape flower Brunkullan. Although Brunkullan is rare, you can some years find hundreds of them here. At Nästmyren you will also find other orchids such as Twayblade and Chalk Fragrant Orchid. **Odensalakärret** is located just 3 km from the citycenter, here you will find the beautiful lady's slipper orchids. There are also Twayblade, Chalk Fragrant Orchid, fly orchid and Royal Helleborine.



Fishing

Fishing with a rod is free on **Lake Storsjön**, no permits are needed. If you prefer to fish in more solitude, the beaches along Andersön also provide interesting fishing for grayling. And the views of the mountains and Åreskutan peak are amazing from here. If you are really in luck, you might even catch a brown trout.

A nice lake for family fishing is **Lillsjön nature area** just 10 minutes from the centre, there is an easily accessible and free family fishing area for perch, pike and stocked rainbow trout.

And if you fancy fishing from a boat on a lake, try **Lake Ösjön** by the village of Lillsjöhögen just some 20 km away. Rental boats, trout and arctic char await the eager fisher. The fishing there is best in early summer. For those who like to fish in running waters, there are plenty of options.

The **Långan and Härkan rivers** run into the **Indalsälven river** at Lit, just 20 km or so to the north of Östersund. Both have lovely streams with good populations of grayling and trout. Fishing in rivers requires a little more skill. You need to be able to manage a fishing rod with a spinner or a fly cast.

GET ACTIVE

When it comes to outdoor activities Östersund is a real multi-sport city. Östersund offers many opportunities for those who want to be active and there is something very special about being able to run, play golf or climb in combination with views of the lake and mountains.

Keep your eyes peeled when you go out, not only for the views, but there is also a good chance you might meet an athlete from one of the Swedish national teams who live and train here.

Climbing

At Östberget, you find over 100 sports climbing routes in a wide range of grades, most of them along bolted routes. For indoor climbing we recommend Östersund Klättercenter, with rope climbing and bouldering.



Hitta ut – Orienteering

An easy and fun way to get exercise while discovering new and beautiful urban forested areas of Östersund. The idea is to find the check points with the help of "Hitta ut" – map or via your mobile/web map. The checkpoints are color coded explaining the difficulty.

Running and hiking

Running is a fantastic way to discover a new city. Frösöberget around is a classic, 8 km asphalt with magnificent views over Östersund, the lake and the mountains. Andersön, outside of Östersund, has beautiful paths in the forest along the lakeside. 11.5 km all the way around,

families appreciate the 2.1 km trail. Bynäset around is also a popular trail, 7 km along the water. At Östersund Ski stadium the blue/white marked trail, 4.5 km, is hilly and technical. Wanting a real challenge? Try the downhill slopes.



Golf

Östersund has 4 golf courses within 20 minutes reach of the city. Frösö golf course, with amazing views over the mountain area. Storsjöbygden's gently hilly and forested golf course, 20 km to the southwest. You reach Norderön Golf course by taking the car ferry to the Pay & Play course. Sandnäset lies 15 km west of Östersund.



Outdoor gyms

There are several outdoor gyms in and around Östersund. At Dalhemsparken, Jamtli, Frösö Park and at Remonthagen the gyms are open to the public and free of charge.



Outdoor yoga

Make most of the summer, bring a mat and go with the flow. Several organizers are offering yoga sessions outdoors. On our website we list pop up sessions regularly.



Roller skis and Biathlon

At Östersund Ski Stadium there is an 8 km long roller ski track. If you like to develop your technique or experience what it is like to be a biathlete for real, Tord Wiksten Event offers courses and events.

Racket sports

At Östersunds Squash center you will find two courts. Tennis is played indoors and outdoors at the Tennis hall. On Frösön, in Torvalla and in Odenskog there are a number of indoor padel halls and at the tennis hall you find an outdoor padel court. Pre-bookings for all racket sports is necessary.
